Recording Deadline ~ Postmarked by January 25, 2019

- All applicants must live within a 500 mile radius of St. Louis
- All applicants must be a member of the Flute Society of Saint Louis
- All applicants must email a typed biography no more than 300 words to flutesocietyofsaintlouis@gmail.com
- The middle/high school applicants must submit a completed reference form from band director or private teacher
- 5 participants and two alternates will be chosen for the Amy Porter masterclass (must be at least 14 years old)
 - Applicants will submit a recording via email to slmonier38@gmail.com
 - Standard works for flute or Orchestral Excerpts
 - Works written for flute and accompaniment must include accompaniment
 - NO personal identification on the recording - Label the recording with title and composer
 - Recordings should not exceed 12 minutes in length
- Applicants for the High School Young Artist Competition must be a current high school or home schooled student
- Applicants for the College Young Artist Competition must be currently enrolled at a university
 - Previous 1st prize FSSL Young Artist winners may not compete for same competition again
- Selected performers will be notified by February 1, 2019
